**HIGH COURT PROCEEDINGS - COLLINS V MALLARD & LITTLE**

We refer to previous correspondence and advise that the High Court proceedings have now been filed.

We are in the process of arranging service of the proceedings on you.

I acknowledge that when we raised this issue with you previously, you were not inclined to adopt a co-operative approach to being served. The fact is that you are now named as a defendant in proceedings before the High Court of New Zealand. Now that you have that formal status, we expect that you would wish to acknowledge your responsibility as a litigant in the court system which would include ensuring early service of the proceedings so the matter can be advanced through the court as quickly as possible.
